Infant School – 8:30-8:55am. **Registration is at 8:55am** so please make sure you are on time. Junior School – 8:30-8:45am. **Registration is at 8:45am** so please make sure you are on time.

Congratulations to Mrs Jones who welcomed baby Oliver to the world in February. We also send our congratulations to Mrs Sexton who gave a birth to a baby girl named Maeve. We know you join us in sending them all our very best wishes.

I am pleased to report that both schools are continuing to achieve above the national average for attendance. The Infant School has dropped slightly and is currently 94.8% but the Junior School has increased and is achieving 96%. Thank you for your combined efforts, lets continue striving for both schools to achieve at least 96%!



All our Year 2 children have now been notified of their places at junior school in September. A letter will be emailed to all parents who are remaining at Springwood Federation with information about the junior school and what to expect. I have also received notification of the children that will begin their school journey in September. I am so pleased to see so many younger siblings joining us and there will be a lot of new faces to get to know over the coming months. Welcome packs have been sent to the new Year R children and the Early Years team will be visiting them all in their homes before the May half term.

SATS Assessments will be taking place this year. Year 2 will begin their end of year assessments during May, Year 6 will sit their tests the week beginning 8th May (note that the 8th is a Bank Holiday for the King's Coronation), Year 1 will complete the Phonics Decoding Check in June and Year 4 will complete the Multiplication Check which is also in June.
