Pupil information



Please keep the school fully informed of any medical/dietary conditions/changes and also ensure your child's asthma inhaler/Insulin/EpiPen etc is in school and in date. Furthermore, please keep the school up-to-date if you change home address, telephone number or email. If you have changed address you will need to provide proof to the office via email before your child's records can be updated. You will need to ensure that there are three named contacts available at any time your child is present in school. One of these contacts should be for someone living outside of the home address e.g. grandparent. It is imperative that we are able to contact an adult to collect the child should they develop symptoms and to safeguard all children.

You should be reporting to the office every day your child is off, giving updated details of the illness and expected return date. If you know your child is going to be absent from school due to going on holiday, please ensure a absence request form has been completed, these forms can be collected from the admin office.
