Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope you all had a lovely half term break. There were days where it felt like Spring and I am certainly enjoying the lighter mornings and evenings.

I am excited to advise you that from Friday 3rd March 2023, children in Early Years will have their own Celebration Assembly where three children in each class will be nominated and receive certificates for upholding each of the school values of 'Staying Safe', 'Treating Each Other as You Wish to be Treated' or 'Try Your Best and Be Proud'. Parents will be invited to share celebrations after Easter.

The joint Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 Celebration Assembly will continue at 8.50am every Friday and parents of nominated children will be invited by text.

After Easter (Friday 21st April 2023), the Federation will begin hosting two celebration assemblies every Friday. EYFS and Key Stage 1 children will attend their assembly at 2.30pm in the Infant Hall and Key Stage 2 will attend their assembly at 8.50am in the Junior Hall. Parents of nominated children will be invited by text to join the celebrations.


As dedicated members of the EARA group, it is our responsibility to ensure all adults and children in the Springwood Federation feel equal and are respected.


