

Please support the school and more importantly the children's safety by only parking in the designated parking spaces outside the school gates.

We have received several concerns over the last few weeks which have been passed on to The Civil Enforcement Officers who will be looking to conduct morning and afternoon visits.

Please also use the designated parking spaces provided in the school car parks when dropping off and collecting your child/ren from school during the school day.

Please keep the school fully informed of any medical/dietary conditions/changes and also ensure your child's asthma inhaler/Insulin/EpiPen etc is in school and in date. Furthermore, please keep the school up-to-date if you change home address, telephone number or email. If you have changed address you will need to provide proof to the office via email before your child's records can be updated. You will need to ensure that there are three named contacts available at any time your child is present in school. One of these contacts should be for someone living outside of the home address e.g. grandparent. It is imperative that we are able to contact an adult to collect the child should they develop symptoms and to safeguard all children.
