Well done to our Year 2 and Year 6 children who have completed all their assessments. Year 1 are busy segmenting and blending words in their phonics check and Year 4 are sharing all the times tables facts they know in their multiplication check.

Your child's End of Year Report will be sent home with them on 14<sup>th</sup> July. The report will detail whether they have met Age Related Expectations (ARE) for their current year and what their next steps are. Years 1 and 4 will have additional information regarding the Phonics Decoding Check and Multiplication Check. Years 2 and 6 will have details about their SATs scores.

The children will meet their new class teachers on Wednesday 5th July and I am sure your child will want to share everything they have learnt about them. There will only be a packed lunch option that day. The staff will be meeting over those few weeks to make sure that they share all the information about your child so they we can ensure there is a smooth transition for September.

Please note: There is no general right to authorise absence for a family holiday. If you take your child out of school without permission the absence will be unauthorised and we will consider legal action. **You are advised not to make any arrangements until your request has been considered.**
