I will be writing to you separately regarding attendance and how **we are striving to meet 95% across the Federation**. Being in school every day and on time will help your child to succeed and meet their full potential.

Please keep the school fully informed of any medical/dietary conditions/changes and also ensure your child's asthma inhaler/Insulin/EpiPen etc. is in school and in date. Furthermore, please keep the school up-to date if you change home address, telephone number or email. If you have changed address you will need to provide proof to the office via email before your child's records can be updated.

Further to my email before half term, you may also receive a phone call this half term to make sure that we hold a third contact (name and number) who is not a family member in case of an emergency.

Please ensure that Junior dinner money is paid in advance for the week through our Sco-Pay system. **The cost of school dinners from 31st October will be £3.00.**

All children in Reception, Year 1 or 2 currently receive a free meal this is called Universal infant free school meals (UIFSM) and you do not need to apply for meals. **If, however, you are a low-income family, and meet the qualifying benefits detailed below, you can help your child's school by submitting a free school meals application to be assessed. Eligibility brings extra funding into the school which means more resources for your child and the school.** Please ask for a member of the Admin team for some support if you think you are eligible.

There continues to be a selection of second hand clothes based in the infant and junior school offices. Please do not hesitate to come have a look and take anything you need.

Should you wish to join (Years 4 and 5 parents only); the Remembrance Service will be held in the Junior hall from 2:15-3:00pm on 10th November 2023. Poppies will be on sale from 1st November.

This year I would like to extend my gratitude to any servicemen and women within our families by inviting them to wear their uniforms with pride and join us as VIPs. Please advise the admin team if you would like a VIP chair reserved by Thursday 9th November 2023.
