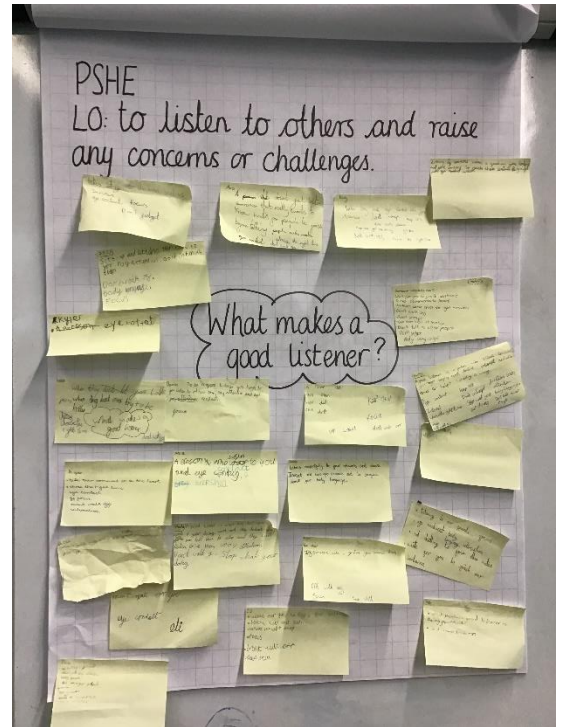
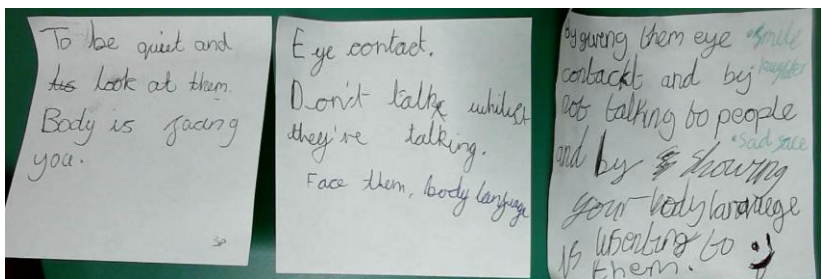
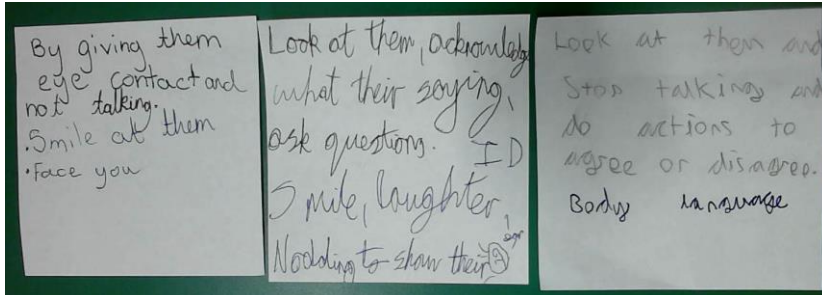


Year 6 PSHE Lesson 1

Learning Objectives: To listen and respond respectfully to a wide range of people, to feel confident to raise their own concerns, to recognise and care about other people's feelings and to try to see, respect and if necessary constructively challenge their points of view.

To begin with, the children completed a pre assessment outline what makes a good listener. They returned to these at the end of the lesson and added what they now knew.



During the lesson, the children played a game of telephone.

The aim was to whisper a message to another child, this message needed to be spread around the class so everyone has passed it on.

The message that was started with had changed as it was passed on. Year 6 had a class discussion about why this happened.

- "It was hard to hear because the person was whispering."
- "We weren't making eye contact."
- "Other people were talking or laughing."
- "It's hard to understand a word or phrase without any context. Without context, what they were saying was really random."



The children shared experiences and thoughts that made them feel happy and how they would want someone to listen.

- Eye contact
- Smiling
- Facing the person they are listening to.
- Asking following up questions.



We discussed how this might change if someone was sharing something that made them feel sad or angry and how we would want to see the other person was listening.

- Eye contact
- Facing the person they are listening to.
- Being empathetic
- Thinking about your facial expression- you wouldn't smile.
